The Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Amendment Rules, 2005

Notification, New Delhi, the 18th January, 2006 G.S.R. 32(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 87 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000), the Central Government hereby makes the following amendments in the Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Rules, 2000, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) (Amendment) Rules, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Rules, 2000, in rule 31, for subrule (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"(2) The Certifying Authority shall conduct half yearly internal audit of the security policy, physical security, planning of its operations and the repository."
