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# The Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Amendment Rules, 2009

**Notification, New Delhi, the 5th August, 2009, G.S.R. 566(E).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 87 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Rules, 2000, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Amendment Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In Information Technology (Certifying Authorities) Rules, 2000, in rule 6 for the letters, figures and words “MD 5 and SHA-1”, the letters, figures and words “SHA-1 and SHA-2” shall be substituted.
